

HEALTHCARE TRAINING



> Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA)

Assists doctors by preparing patients, taking vital signs, collecting specimens, conducting EKGs, and aiding during exams and procedures.

> Certified Medical Administrative Assistant (CMAA)

Handles patient reception, appointments, insurance claims, and phone inquiries, covering various office tasks.

Certified Nursing Assistant/Geriatric Nursing Assistant (CNA/GNA)

Provides basic patient care under nurse supervision, including feeding, dressing, grooming, mobilizing, and linen changes.

> Community Health Worker (CHW)

Connects healthcare providers, social services, and communities, for equitable access to resources and services to enhance community health.

> CPR and First Aid

American Heart Association courses including HeartSaver First Aid, CPR, AED, BLS for Healthcare Providers (initial and renewal), and HeartCode CPR.

> Certified Medicine Aide

Designed for GNAs to prepare, administer, and chart non-parenteral medications in long-term care facilities.

> Dental Assistant

Supports dentist by preparing instruments and materials, maintaining sterilization protocols, organizing trays for procedures, and advising patients on postoperative and general oral care.

> Nurse Refresher

Enhances the knowledge and skills of nurses (LPNs and RNs) returning to nursing practice, ensuring their competency and readiness for re-entry into the workforce.

> Patient Care Technician (PCT)

Designed for CNAs/GNAs seeking to enhance their skills, including EKGs, venipuncture, IV administration, urinary catheter management, wound/ostomy/splint care, and specimen collection.

> Phlebotomy Technician

Works in outpatient labs at hospitals, clinics, or patient centers, specializing in blood collection from patients or donors.

> Veterinary Assistant

Skilled in operating medical equipment, administering vaccinations, restraining animals during procedures, providing wound care, and advising clients on pet wellness.
